Level One (health check): <u>\$20 redeemable against any further work</u>

- Bike will be visually and mechanically inspected including frame wipe-down
- A detailed written report will be provided which includes assessment of mechanical condition of bicycle, service recommendations and approximate cost of any work and parts required

Level Two (intermediate Service, ideal as seasonal service for bikes in good mechanical condition): <u>\$70 plus cost of parts:</u>

this includes Level One service, in addition to:

- Full adjustment of derailleurs, shifters and brakes
- Replacement and lubrication of inner cables (outer housing only if necessary)
- Light truing of wheels and tightening all bolts to correct torque spec.
- Inflating tires to correct pressure
- If required, cockpit adjustments and basic fit tweaks
- Clean and degrease of drivetrain
- Replacement of chain and/or cassette, if required

Level Three (comprehensive service): <u>\$95 plus cost of parts:</u> This includes Levels One and Two, plus:

• Complete replacement of all drivetrain inner and outer cables

- Replacement of brake pads
- Extensive cleaning (and replacement if required) of frame and drivetrain components. This service up is ideal for bikes that have seen a lot of use, or bikes that might have some worn out parts.

Level Four (complete disassembly, cleaning and rebuild of your bicycle frame OR building up a new frame) \$190 plus cost of parts

Full frame rebuild: A complete disassembly, cleaning and reassembly of bicycle, including repacking bearings with fresh grease, re-cabling of drivetrain and replacement of any worn components. Also includes full drivetrain removal, cleaning, as well as the labor for any new component installation.

P.S. Suspension service beyond cleaning & inspection of suspension components is billed separately (see below)

If no service package is required, individual service item rates are as follows:

- Drivetrain tune up 35\$ (plus cost of any inner & outer cables, if required)
- Re-cabling \$35 (plus cost of inner and outer cables)
- Minor wheel truing \$15/wheel
- Major wheel truing \$20/wheel

- Spoke replacement: 1-3 spokes \$25 plus cost of parts inclusive of wheel truing and tension check

- Brake adjustment (rim or V-brake) \$15 per brake
- Brake adjustment with cable replacement \$20 (plus cost of any cables or brake pads)
- Brake bleeding for hydraulic brakes \$20 per brake
- Tire/tube installation \$15 per wheel (plus cost of new tire or tube, if required)
- Derailleur installation and adjustment \$30
- Shifter installation and adjustment \$30
- Chainring installation \$20
- Crankset installation \$30
- Complete drivetrain installation \$80
- Tubeless tire installation \$20 per tire including tubeless sealant (+ \$10 for tape refresh)
- Bottom bracket installation \$25
- Grips replacement \$15 (plus cost of new grips if needed)
- Bar tape replacement \$20 (plus cost of new bartape)
- Misc. parts installation \$5-\$25 depending on part (please test for quote)
- Rear suspension shock service \$60 (plus cost of service kit)
- Suspension fork lower leg service and dust wiper replacement \$65 (plus cost of service kit)
- Suspension fork damper service: starts at \$90 + parts (TO BE QUOTED BASED ON FORK MODEL
- + plus cost of service kit)
- Bike packing for travel \$40 (bike travel box rentals available)

We can source parts and spares if required and you will be notified of cost in advance, or customer can provide any parts to be replaced but must ensure compatibility with their bike(s) or other parts required.
